The award-winning Cross extending table by Matthew Hilton is a fine example of advanced wood manufacturing techniques. The simple lines of this modern design creates a distinctly timeless piece which is practical and adaptable.

Made from a solid wood base, with a veneered top, it has two extendable leaves to fit the entire family. At its smallest, the table can seat 8 people. Fully extended, with both leaves inserted, it can seat 12.

The Cross extending table received the Elle Decoration Award for Best in Furniture in 2006, won the Homes & Gardens Classic Design Award in 2007 and was awarded the coveted Design Guild Mark in 2008.

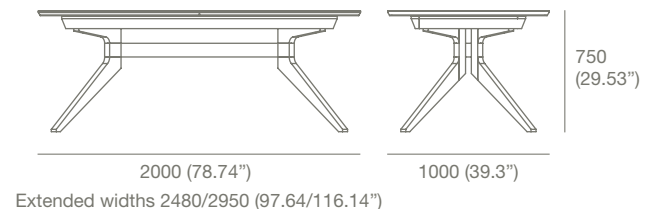
Key Features

- Made in Europe

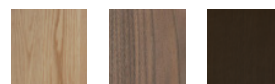
Technical / Construction
