

Ole Wanscher was integral to the aesthetic and functionality of modern Danish design as exemplified by the OW150 daybed. The clean, classic daybed, designed in 1963, features a single long cushion that appears to float above an angular, solid oak frame. It clearly shows how Wanscher was intrigued and inspired by classic furniture design.

#### DESIGNER

Ole Wanscher (1903–1985) was integral to the core aesthetic and function-ality of modern Danish Design. He had the unique ability to add structural dimension to his furniture. Both his classic and contemporary designs made him popular. Today, his modern classics are still revered for their detail and his deep respect for materials.
