

Charge

Plug the USB cable supplied into a suitable power outlet, and insert the small connector into the underside of the lamp. It will show a red light while charging and green light when fully charged.



Rotate

You can rotate the light 360°



Light intensities

1st touch - 25% 2nd touch - 50% 3rd touch - 100% 4th touch - Switch off

Special attention when using the battery:

- It can take up to 7 hours to charge the battery to full (where the charging light turns green) when it is used for the first time.
- Ideal charging current is 0.5c.
- The charging duration varies according to the charging current.
- Using the lamp when plugged in can shorten the life of the battery.
- If the lamp is not used for a considerable time, please do remember to charge the battery at an interval of every 3 months.

- 6. To clean this lamp use soft damp cloth, with soap or neutral detergent. Do not use alcohol or other solvents.
