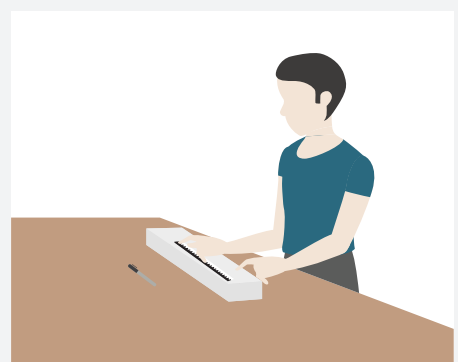




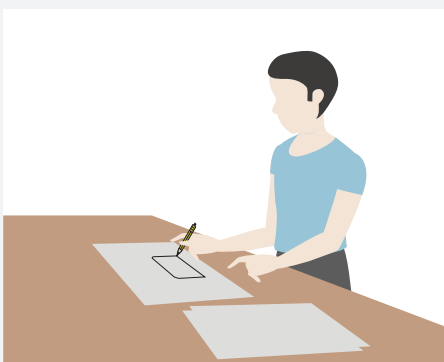
★ CAD DRAWINGS ARE A HELPFUL GUIDE

While CAD drawings are useful guides, they may not fully capture the natural character of the physical materials used. This is because 2D digital models have limitations in representing the final 3D object.



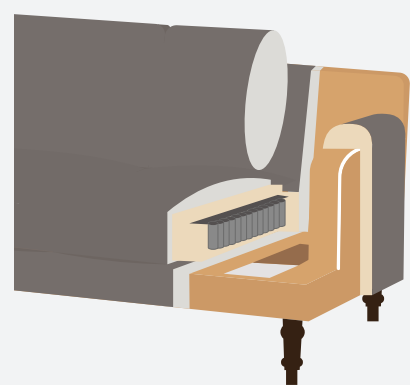
★ SOFT FILLINGS AND ORGANIC UPHOLSTERY PROCESS

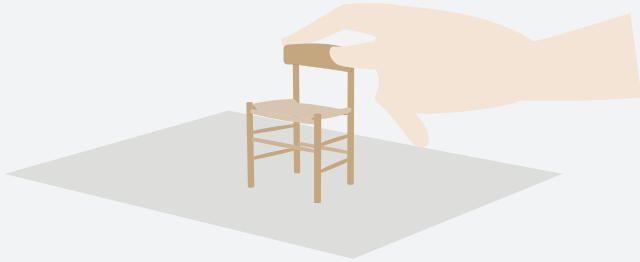
★ ALWAYS AN ORIGINAL PIECE

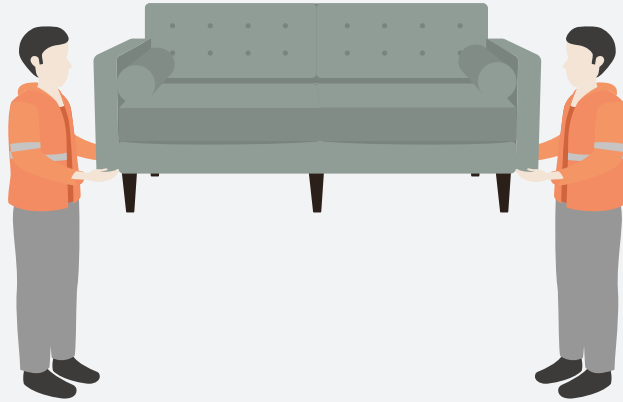
★ MAKING A BESPOKE PIECE FOR THE FIRST TIME

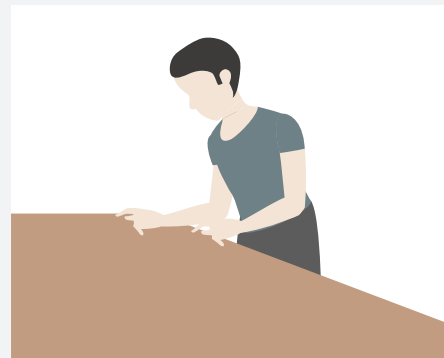
★ FACTORS AFFECTING MANUFACTURING TIMES

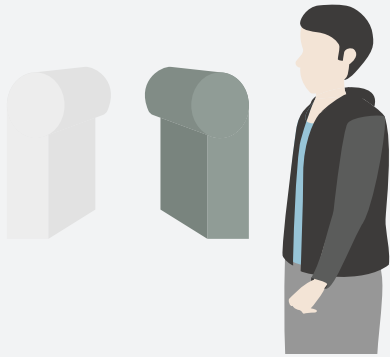
★ HANDMADE CHARM AND CHARACTER

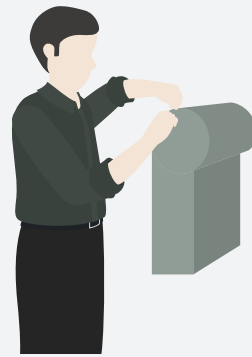
★ EVERY PIECE IS UNIQUE
