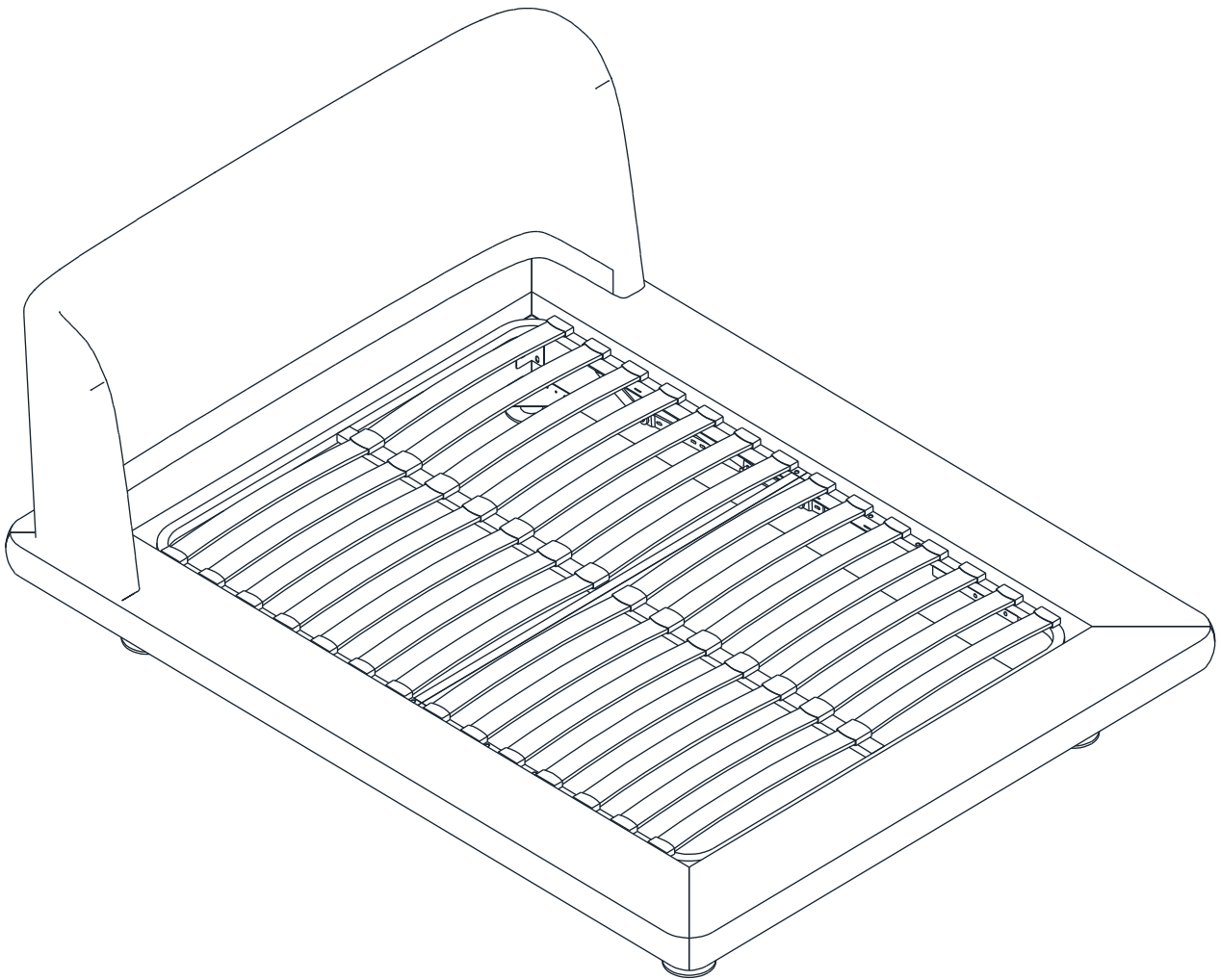


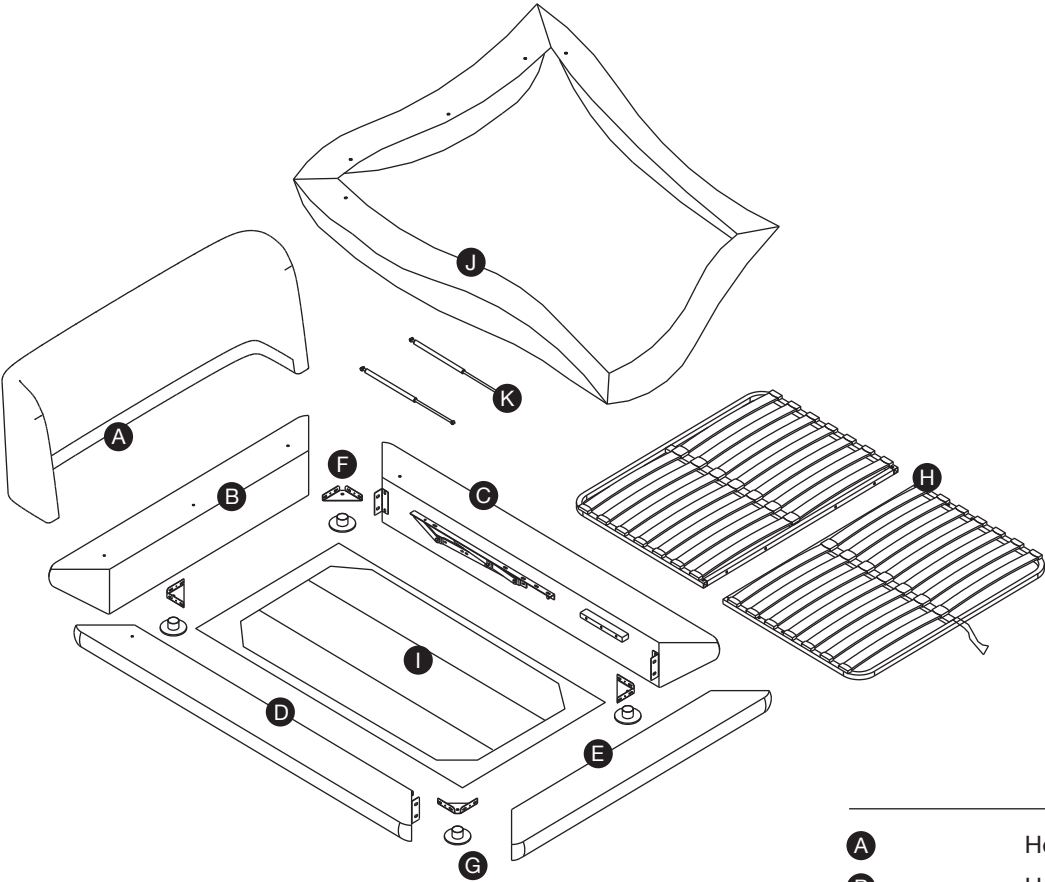
Galera Bed

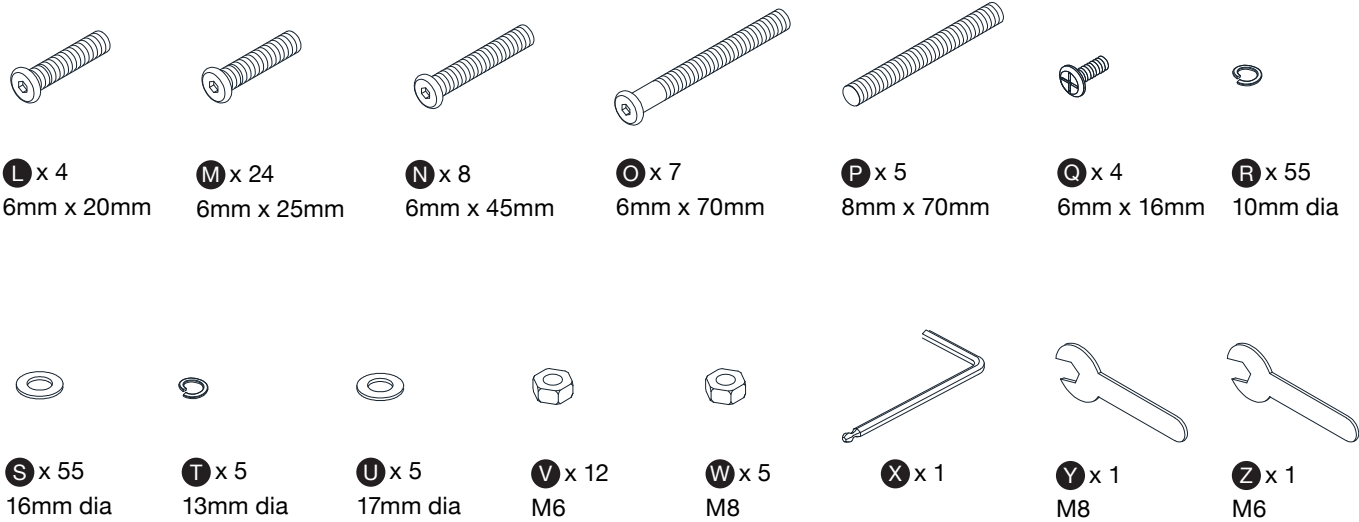


Assembly Instructions

Assembly requires two people and can take upto an hour.
Assemble the bed close to final destination. Identify all parts and hardware before starting assembly. Retain packaging until bed is fully assembled to ensure no fittings or components are accidentally discarded. Make sure assembly area is clean and level.

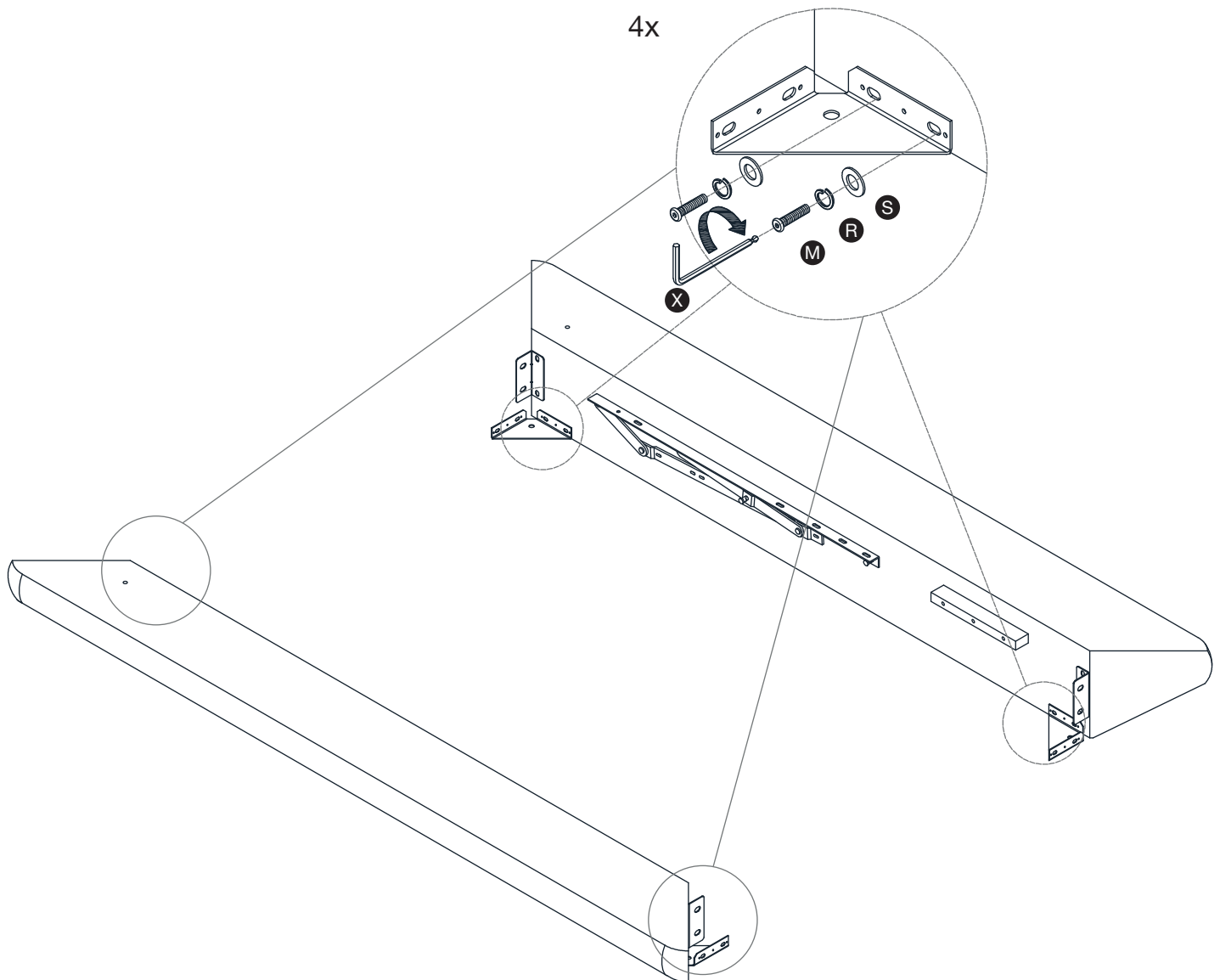


- A** Headboard
- B** Headboard Rail
- C D** Side Rails
- E** Footboard Rail
- F** Corner Bracket
- G** Leg
- H** Slat Frame
- I** Storage Mat
- J** Slipcover
- K** Gas Struts



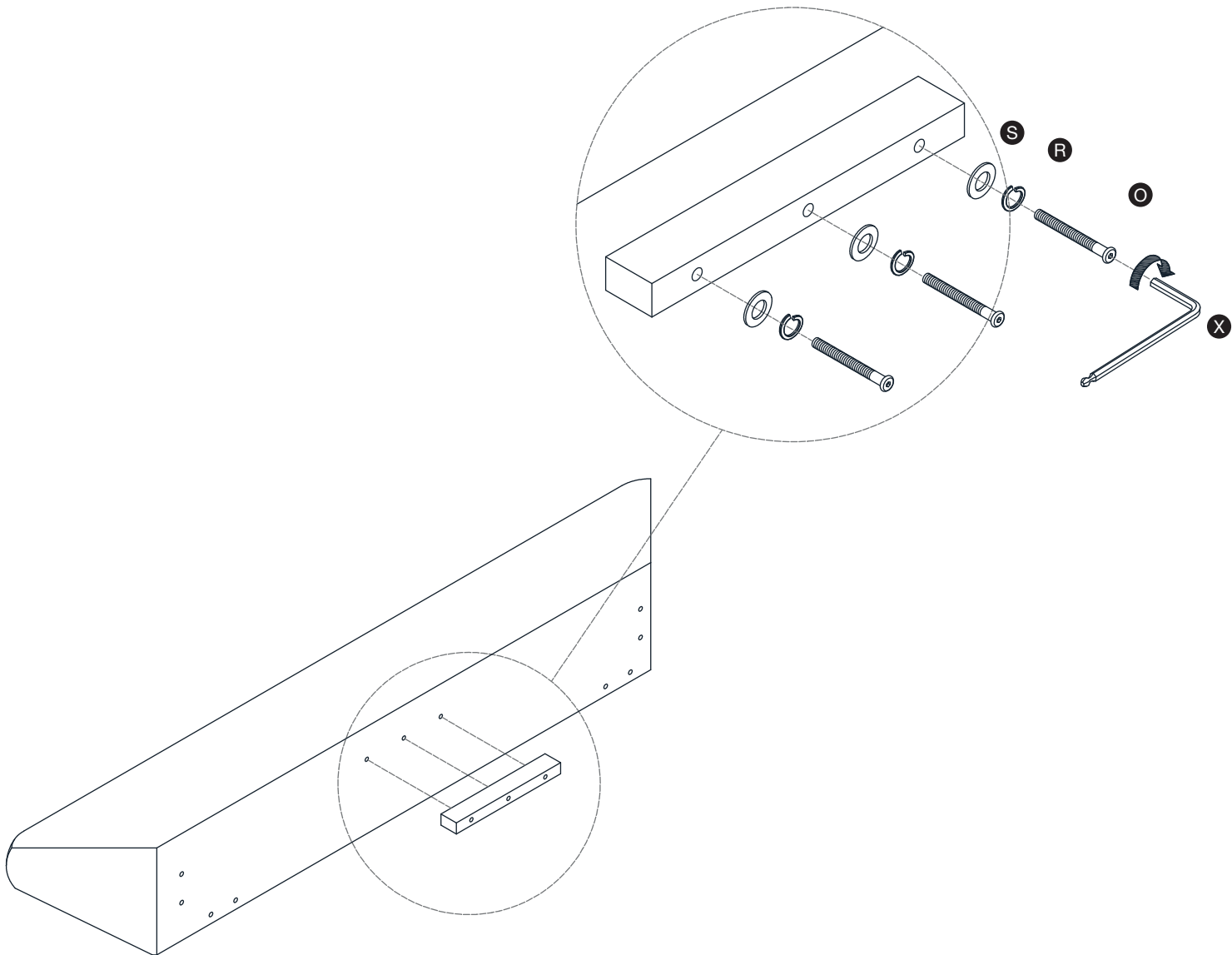
Step 01

Fix 4 x corner brackets (F) to side rails (C,D) with 8 x fittings (M, R + S) and allen key (X).



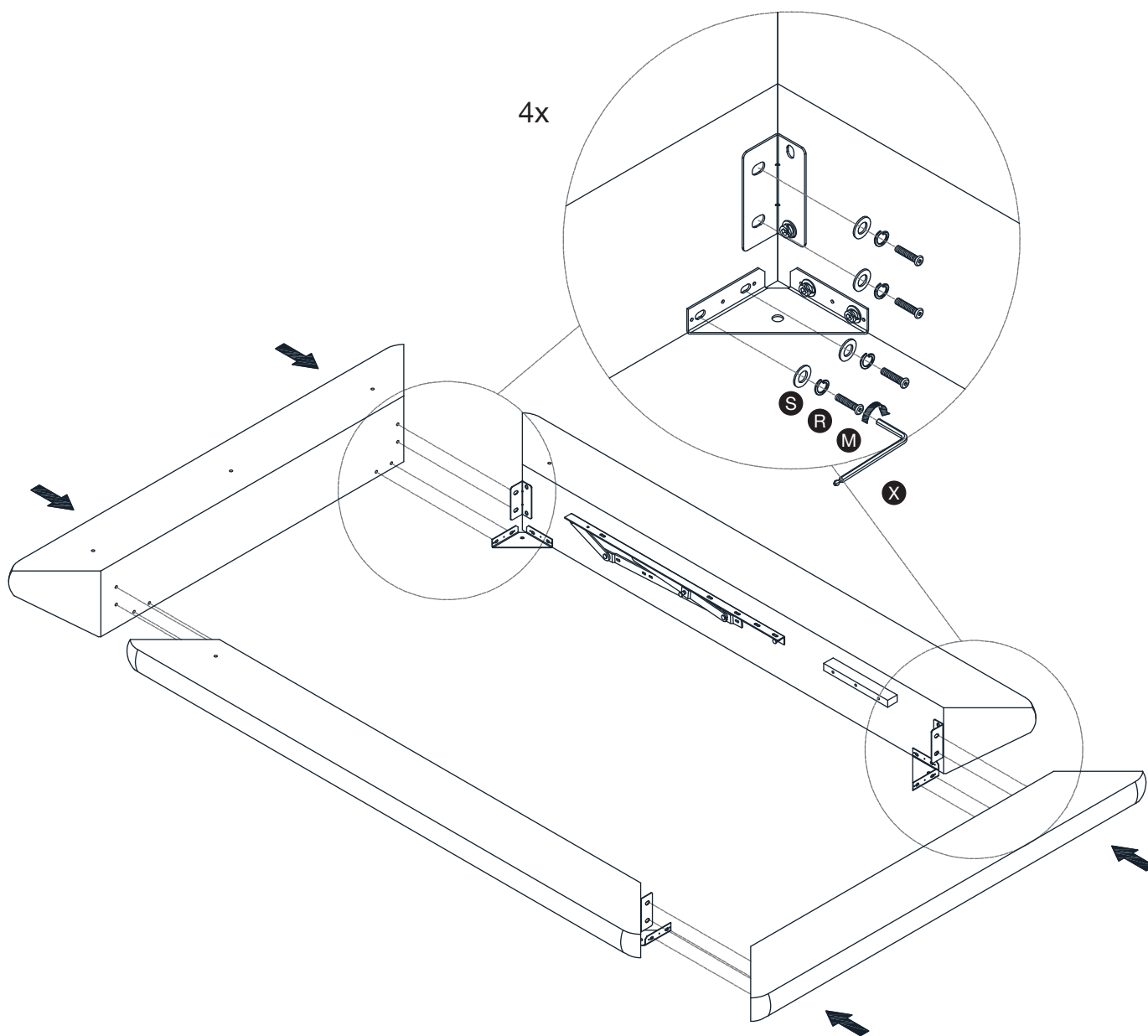
Step 02

Secure the support rails to footboard rails (E) with 3 x fittings (O, R + S) and allen key (X).



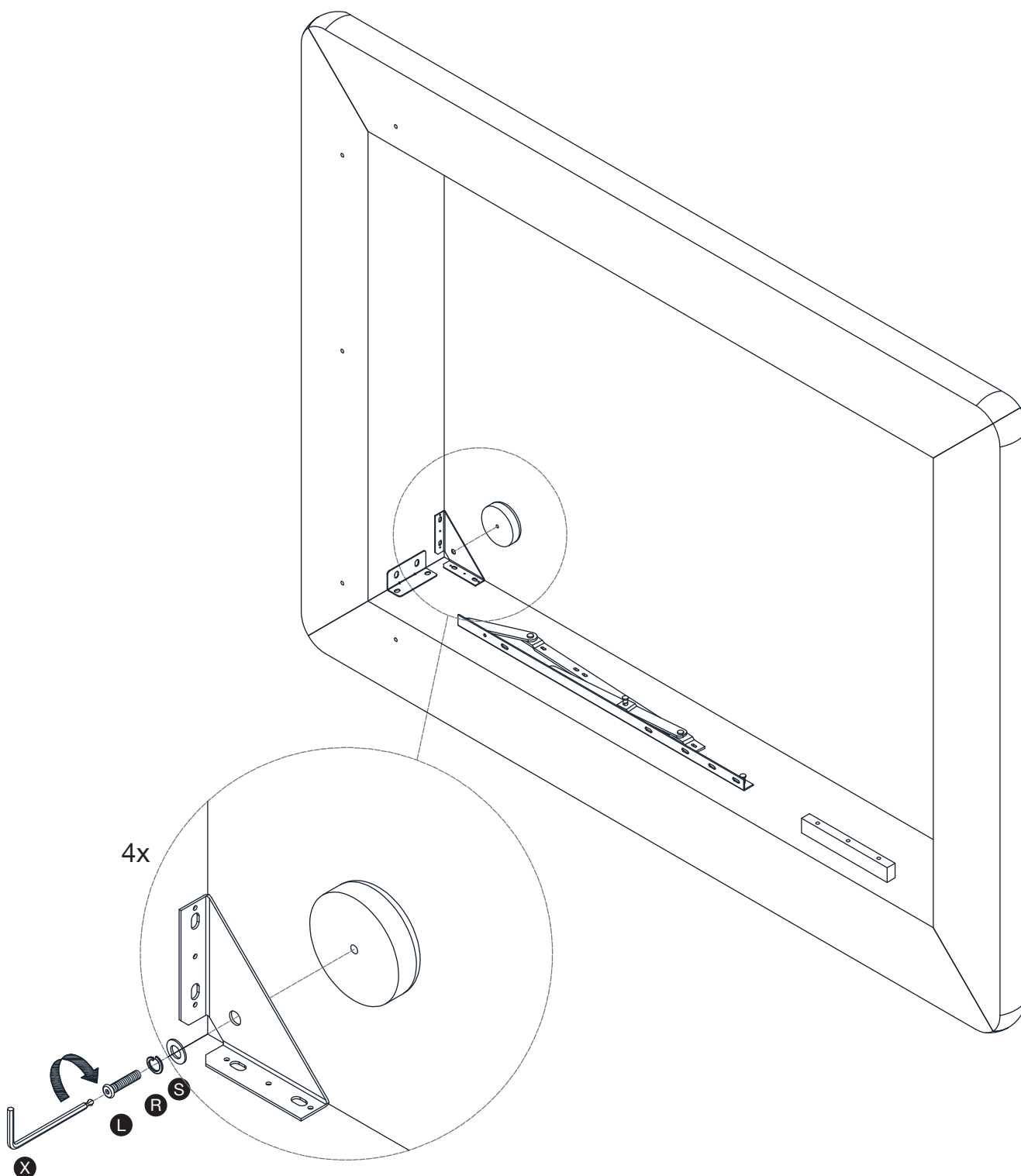
Step 03

Secure the rails (B,E) to rails (C,D) with 16 x fittings (M, R + S) and allen key (X).



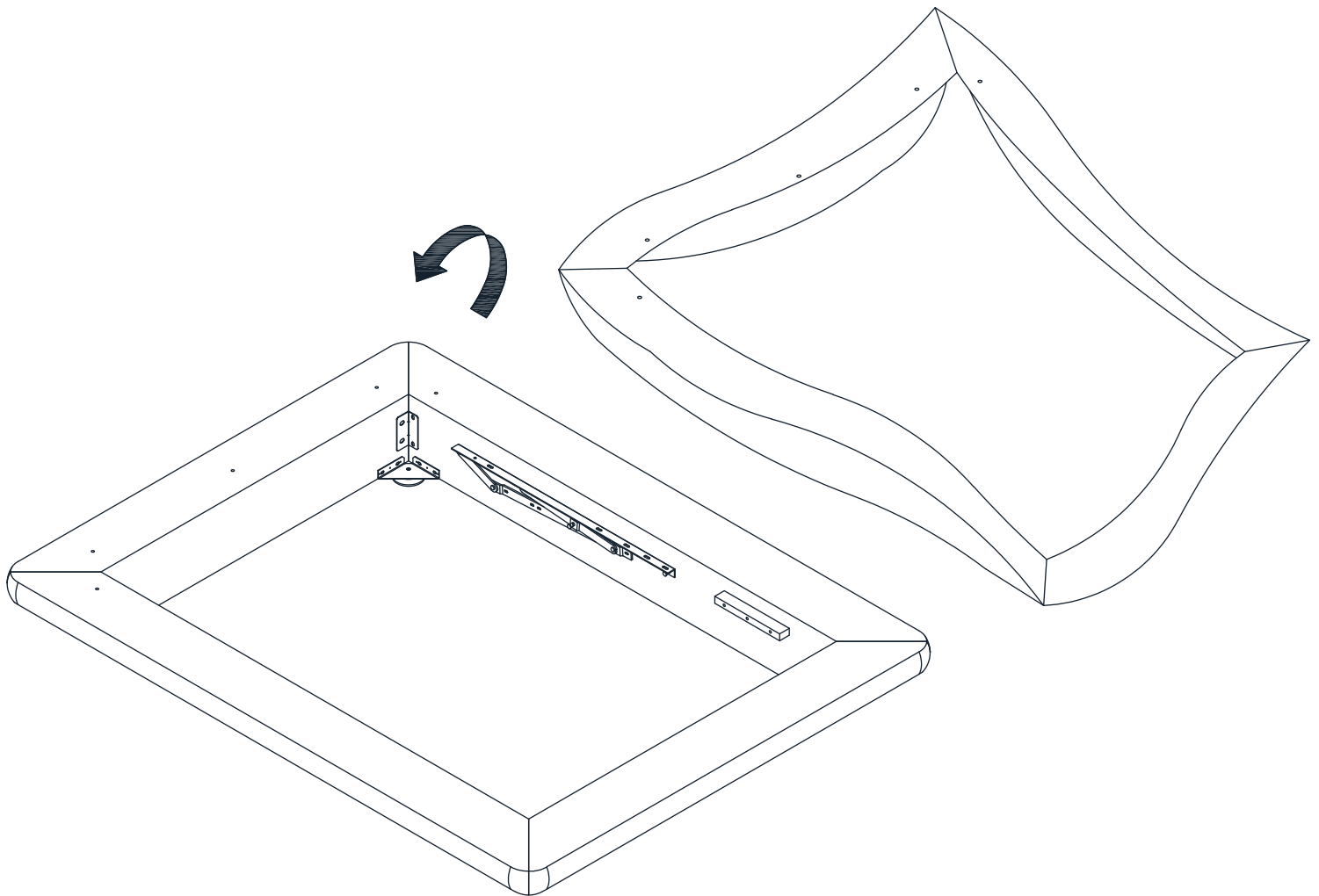
Step 04

Secure 4 x legs (G) to brackets (F) by fixing 4 x fittings (L, R + S) with allen key (X).



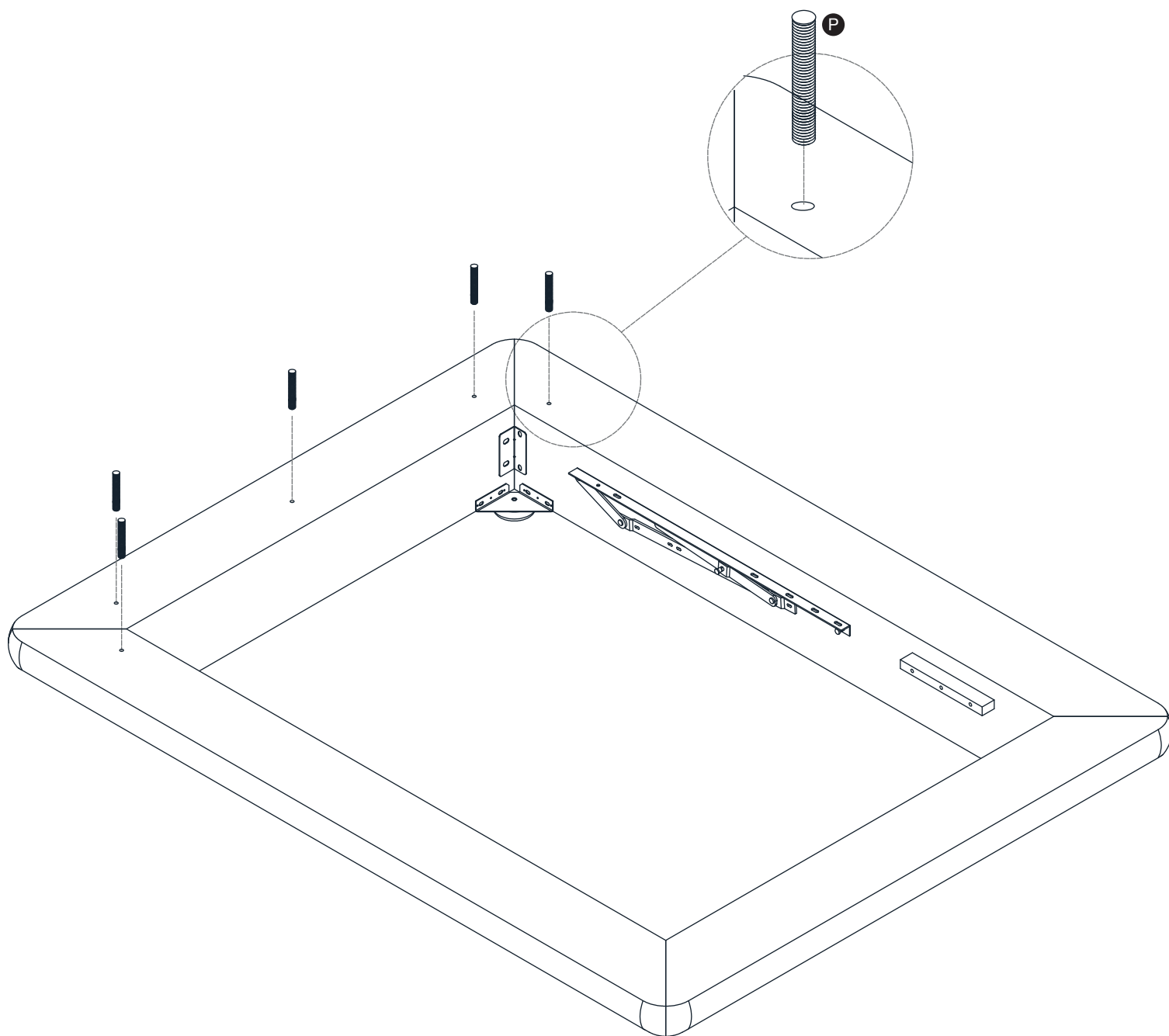
Step 05

Attach the slip cover (J) to the assembled frame. Ensure that the corners are aligned and that the holes at the headboard end are aligned to allow fittings to pass through.



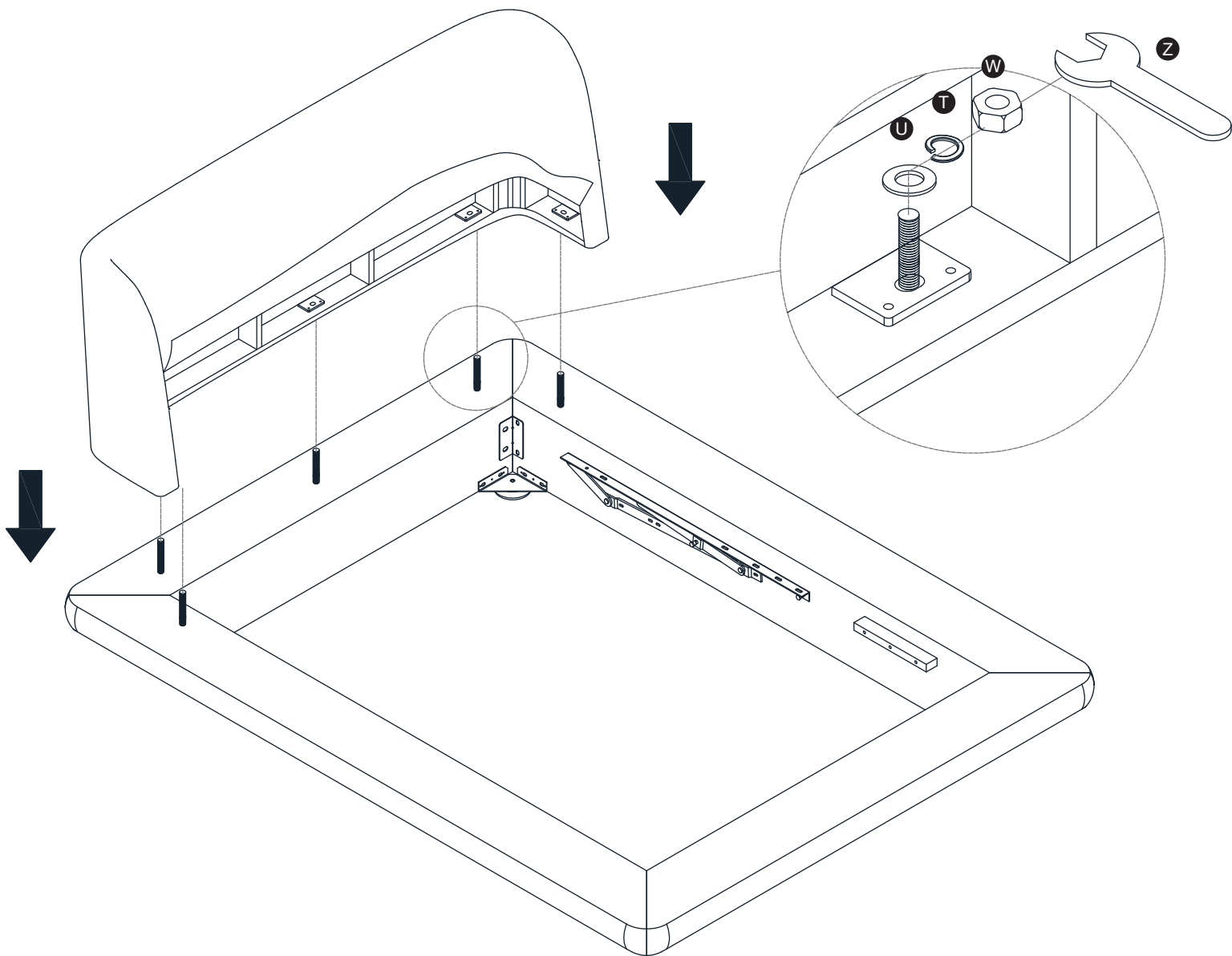
Step 06

With the bed standing upright, insert 5 x fittings (P) into the holes in the frame. Tighten these by hand until fully secure.



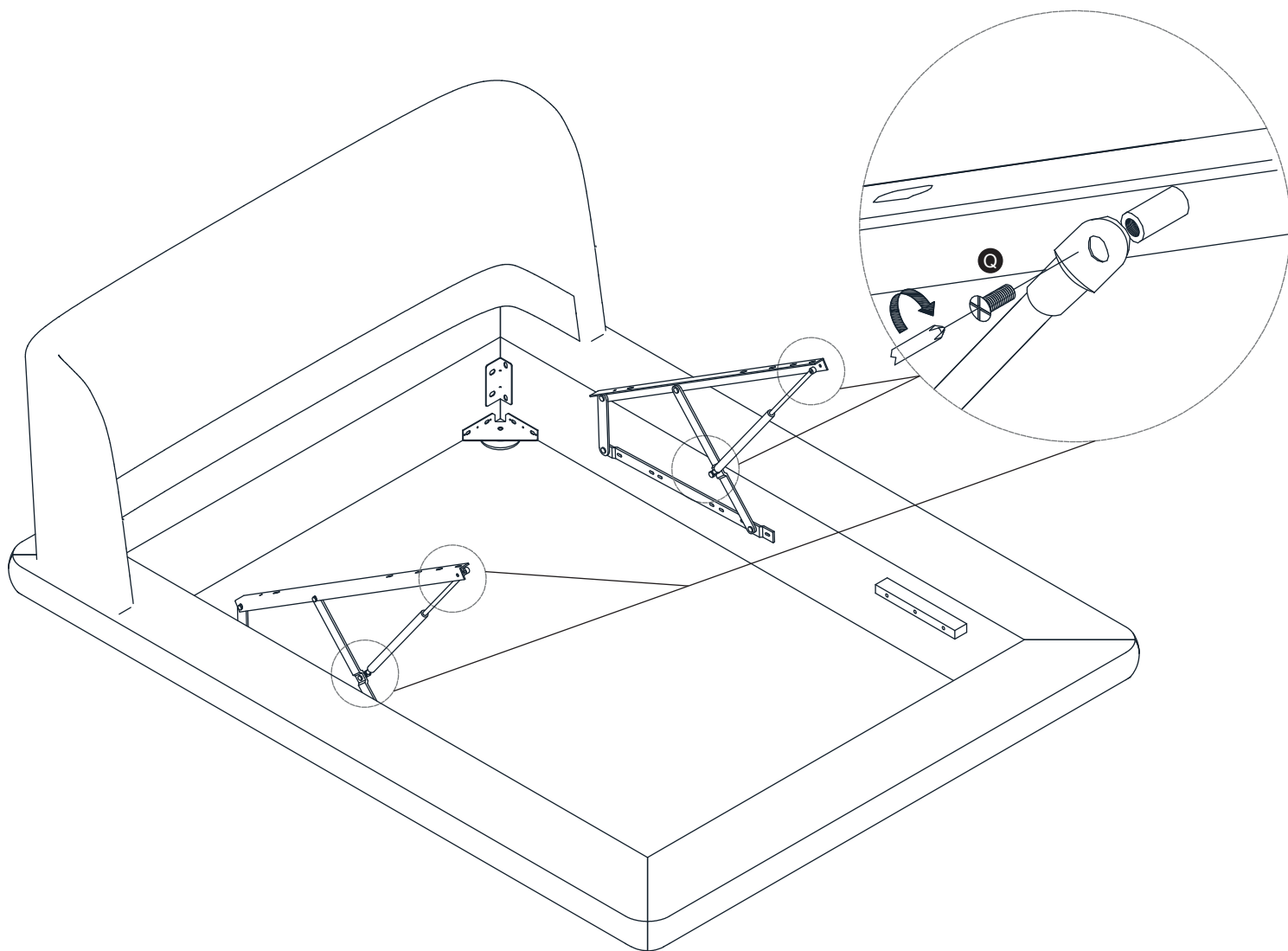
Step 07

Place the headboard over the 5 x fittings that have been secured to the frame ensuring all holes are unobstructed. When the headboard is in place - open the cover on the inside of the headboard and secure to each threaded rod with 5x fitting (U, T + W) and fully tighten with spanner (Z).



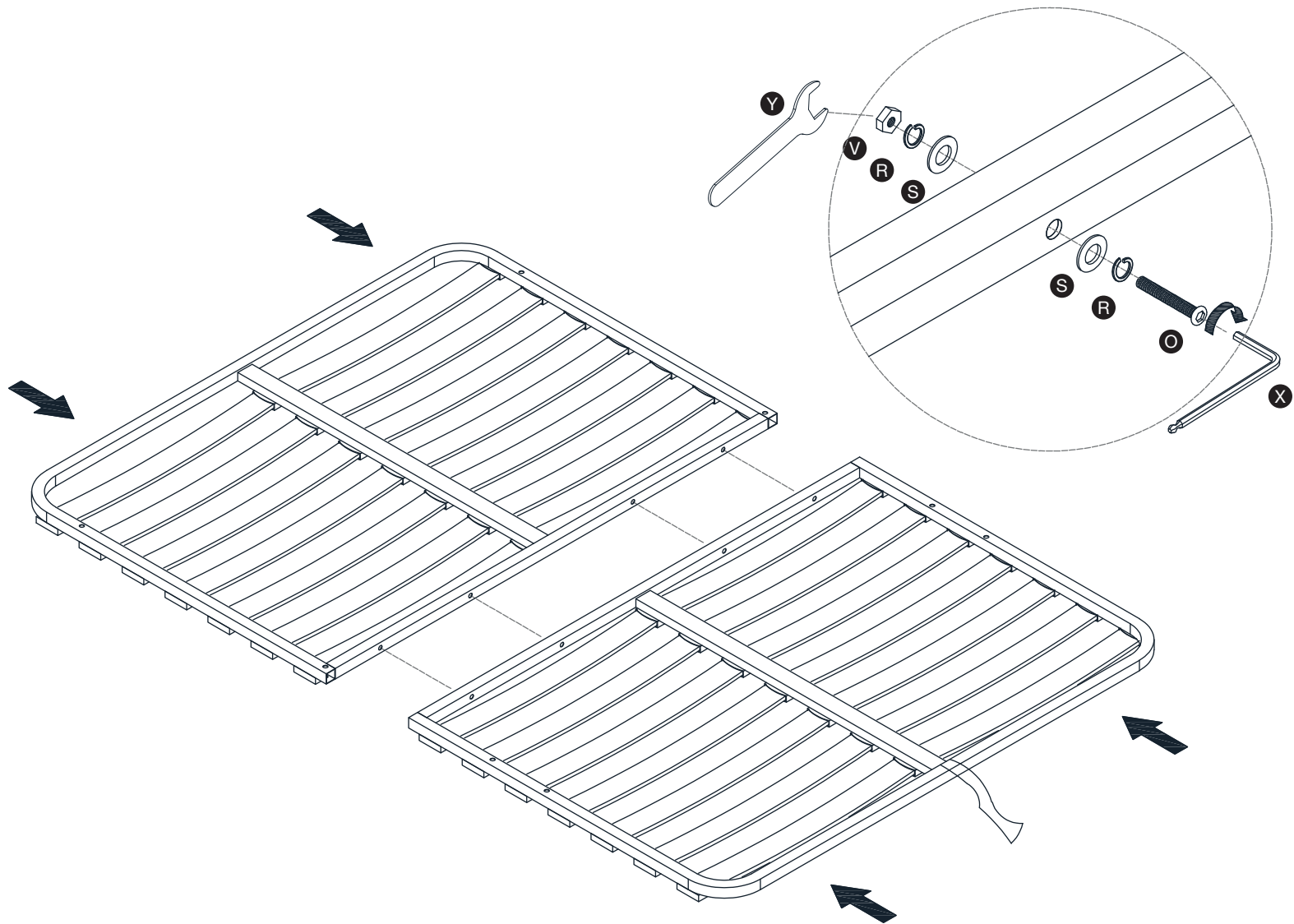
Step 08

Attach the gas struts (K) to the frame storage rails.
Secure with 4 x screws (Q) and tighten with a phillips head
screwdriver.



Step 09

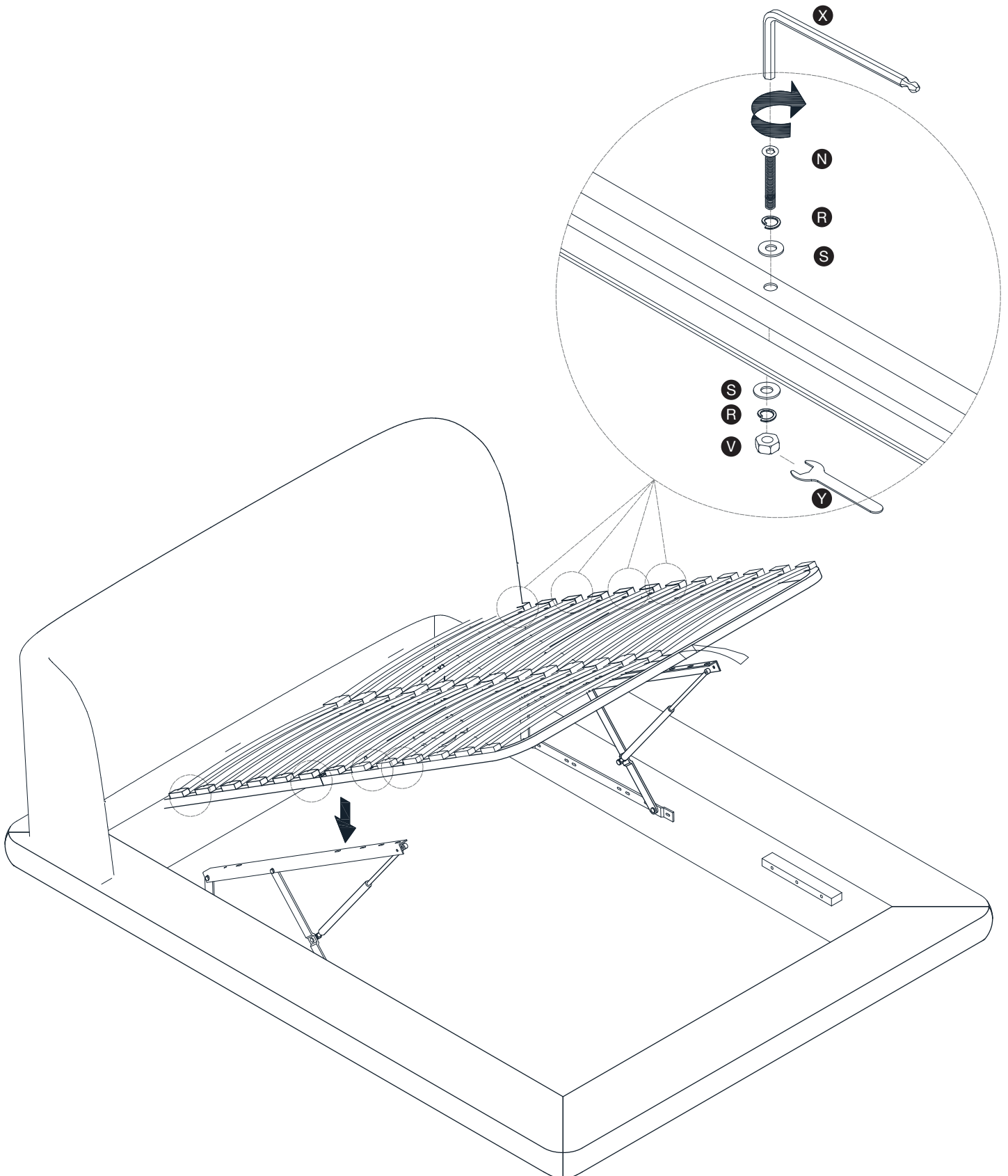
Join the two halves of the slat frame (H) together with 4 x fitting (V, R, S, S, R, O) and secure firmly with spanner (Y) and allen key (X)



Step 10

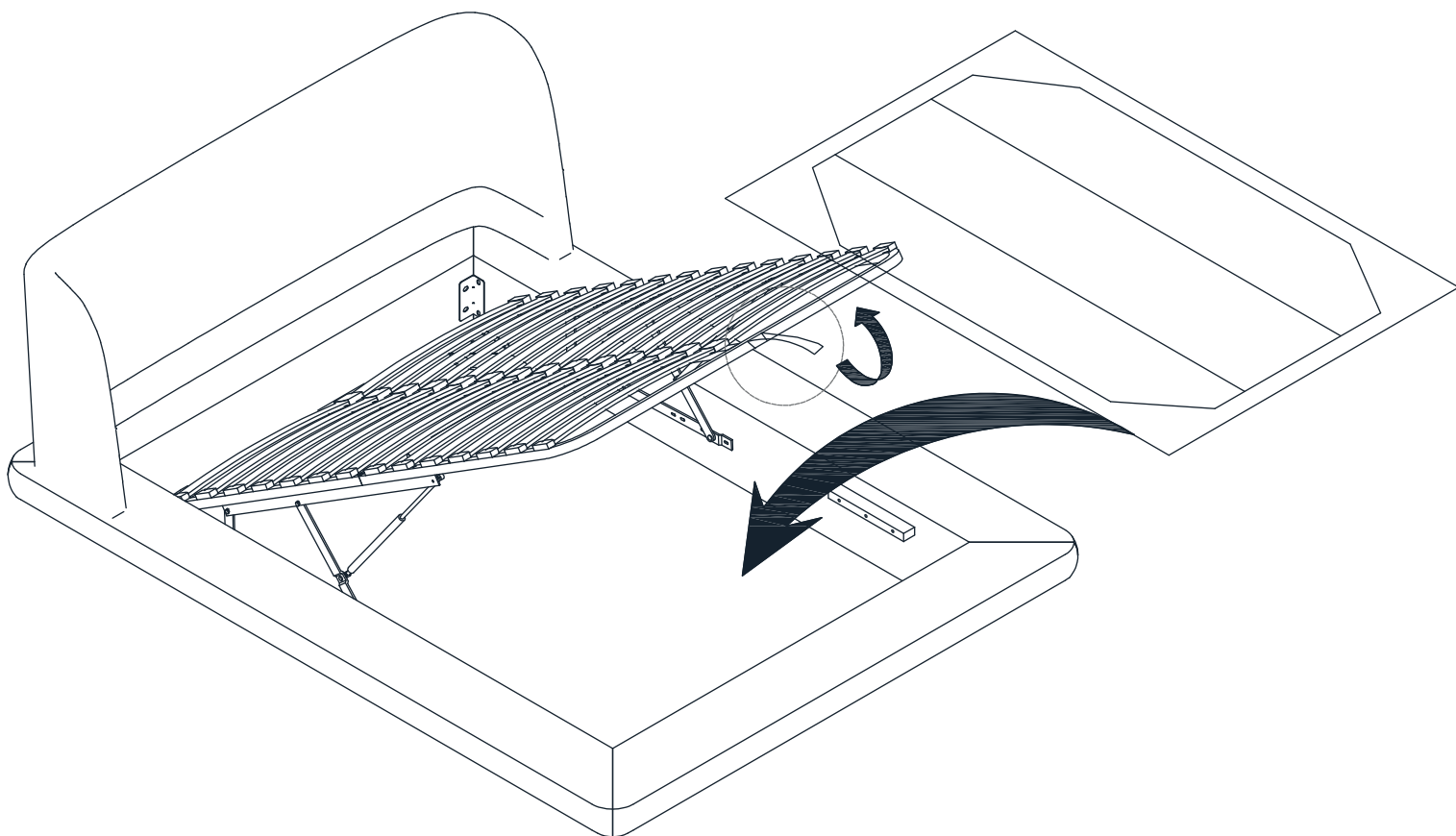
Fix the assembled bed slat frame onto the lift up strut arm on the frame - ensuring the fabric handle for the lift mechanism is at the footboard end.

Secure this into place with fittings (N, R, S, S, R + V) fully tighten with spanner (Y) and allen key (X)



Step 11

Insert the storage mat (J) into the storage compartment of the bed. Unfold and secure the sides and ends into position with the Velcro applied. Ensure the mat sits neatly on the floor without any tension.



To prolong the life of the product and retain its appearance and functionality, we would like to give you some relevant information and care advice:

General Care:

- Fluff headboard periodically to promote uniform wear and to help maintain comfort.
- Have upholstered items professionally cleaned when needed (we recommend around once per year).
- Place furniture out of direct sunlight to help prevent fading. Avoid placing furniture near fireplaces or radiators.
- Remove gum or wax by freezing it with a small plastic bag of ice until it hardens, then gently chip away. Repeat as necessary and blot with a damp, clean cloth to remove any stain left behind.
- Prevent spills from turning into stains by blotting them immediately with a clean dry cloth. Always blot from the outer edge of a spill inward to help avoid a stain ring from forming. Do not use water to remove oil-based stains.
- Use clear, cool water to help blot up resistant spills. Never use hot water, which tends to set stains.

Fabric Cleaning:

- Do not use cleaning solvents of any kind.
- Never let water saturate fabric or pool in seams.
- Brush pile fabrics lightly with a stiff bristle brush to remove minor stains and to regain original appearance. Do not rub or use excessive force when brushing.
- Professional cleaning is recommended.

Leather Cleaning:

- Dust is the enemy of leather upholstery, causing it to wear excessively and crack. Remove dust by wiping away with a dry cloth regularly and vacuum using the appropriate attachments. Do not use dust-cleaning products intended for wood furniture, which can damage leather.
- Some stains will blend into leather over time and become part of its patina.
